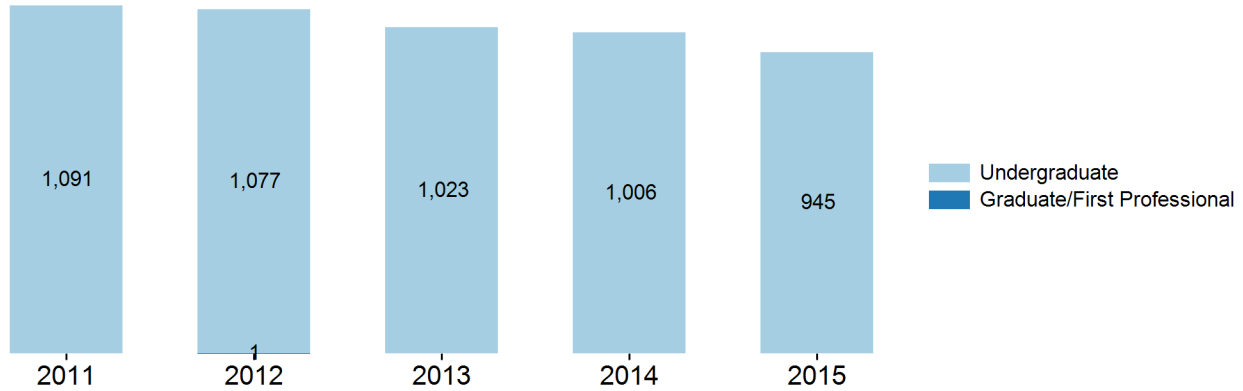

Fall Headcount Enrollment - Five-Year Trend



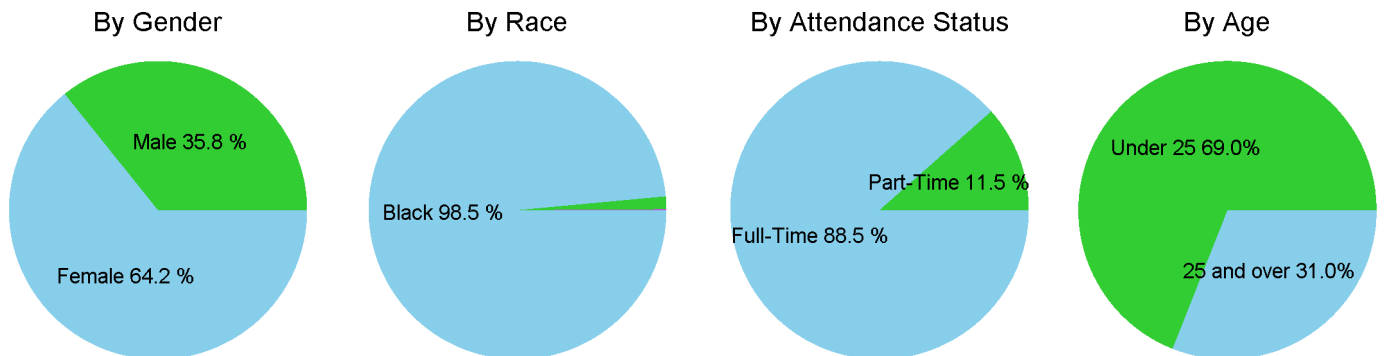

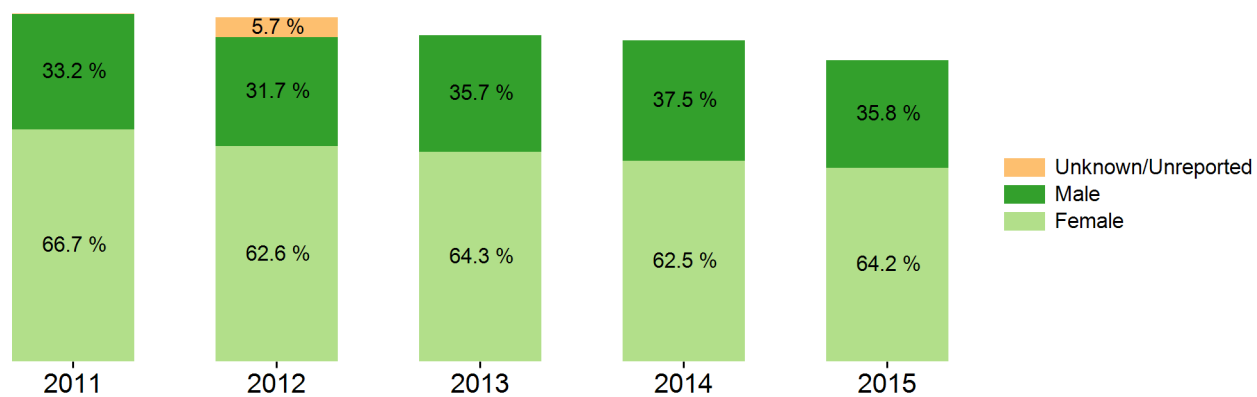

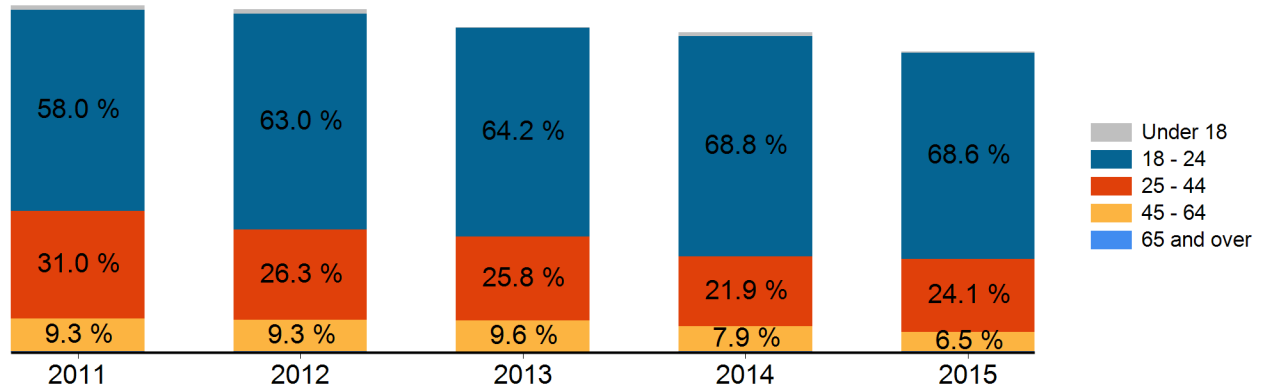

Fall Headcount by Gender - Five-Year Trend



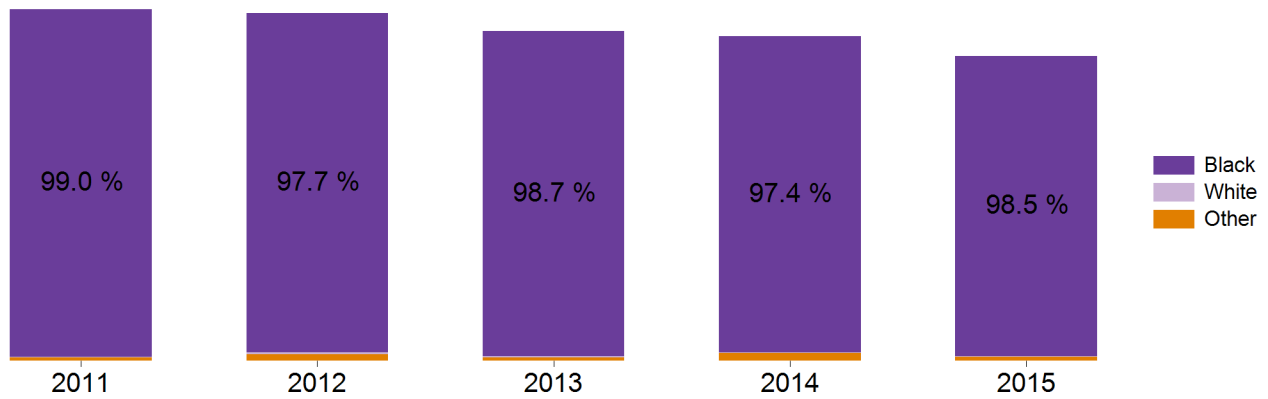

Fall Headcount by Race/Ethnicity - Five-Year Trend

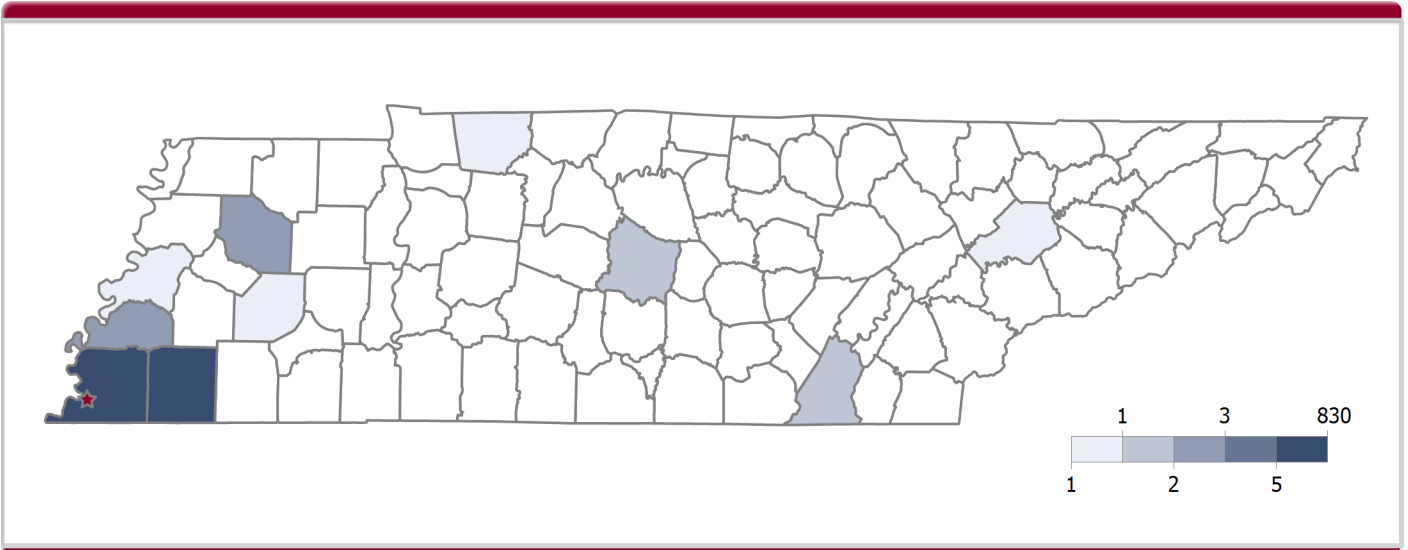

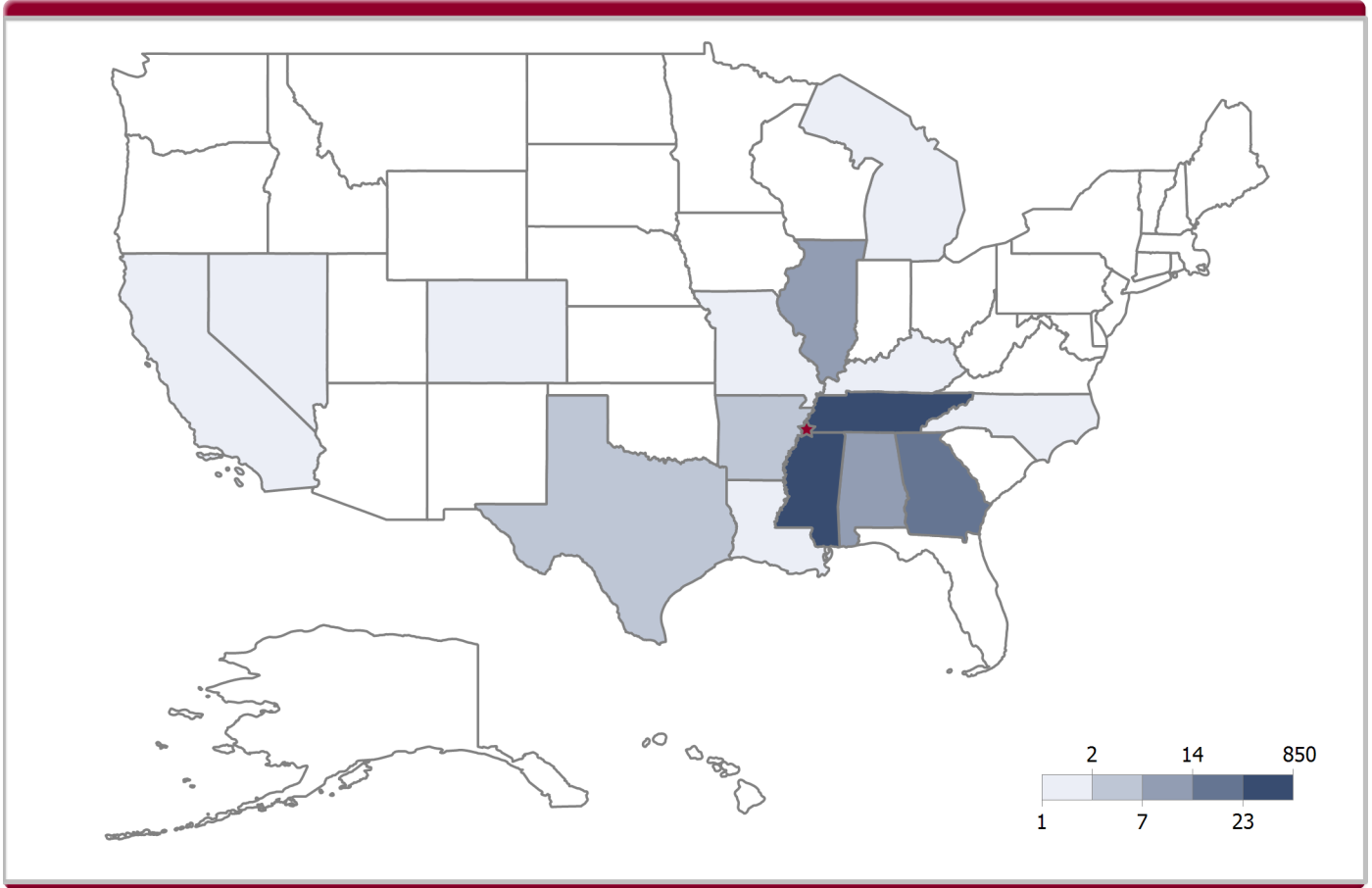
