I. Purpose and statement of operational policy underlying the procedure.

The purpose of this policy is to create and maintain a healthy environment for all College personnel and students. The Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989 and signed by President Bush on December 2, 1989, required that by October 1, 1990, institutions must certify to the United States Department of Education that they have adopted and implemented a program to prevent the illicit use of drugs and the abuse of alcohol by students and employees.

II. Applicability/Scope

In compliance with the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989, LeMoyne-Owen College prohibits on its premises or at any of its activities the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance by any student or employee.

III. Process for Implementing Procedure

The only exception and legal possession and consumption of alcohol on campus is limited to College Sanctioned Special Events which have been approved, in writing, by the President's Cabinet.
